SUMMARY INFORMATION for April 2008

Precipitation averaged below normal over all four sectors of our network during April. Monthly precipitation totals at individual stations ranged from 1.30 inches at Thornapple Country Club 1N in western Franklin County, and at Otterbein College 2SSE in Westerville (northeastern Franklin County) to 3.70 inches at Powell 2NE in southwestern Delaware County. Sector averages for the month were as follows: NW = 1.96"; NE = 2.15"; SE = 2.30", and SW = 1.97". The 4-sector average for the month was 2.10 inches; normal precipitation for the month of April at Port Columbus is 3.25 inches. Port Columbus officially reported no snowfall during April; normal snowfall for April is 1.7 inches. The total seasonal snowfall at Port Columbus still stands at 45.3 inches; normal snowfall for the period of October through April at Port Columbus is 28.5 inches. The most significant storms to affect the Central Ohio area during April occurred during the period of April 25-29.

The precipitation that fell during the period of April 25-29 was associated with two different storm systems. Widely scattered, mainly light rains fell on the mornings of the 25th and 26th in association with the approach and passage of a low pressure center and cold front. After the system passed through Ohio, however, the low pressure center became stationary over central West Virginia, and Gulf moisture tracked up along and behind this system from the southwest into Ohio, providing us with steadier and heavier rainfall from the evening of the 27th into the pre-dawn hours of the 28th. Finally, another low pressure center and cold front pushed into Ohio from the west during the late afternoon of the 28th, bringing with it additional showers and some thundershowers during the evening of the 28th into the early morning hours of the 29th. As a final parting blow ... in some areas outside of Columbus' I-270 outerbelt, especially to the north and east, the precipitation ended with a burst of heavy snow ... covering the ground in some areas. Our observer at Johnstown 6ENE in Licking County reported 2.5 inches of snowfall on the ground on the morning of the 29th! Total liquid precipitation from these two storms added up to between 0.5 and 1.5 inches at most locations within our official 10-county Central Ohio area, with the heaviest amounts generally reported from Licking County and southern Delaware County.

Even with the below-normal precipitation during April, calendar year precipitation is still averaging well above normal over all four sectors of our network. Annual totals at individual stations range from 13.25 inches at Indian Meadows Park in Dublin (northwestern Franklin County) to 20.60 inches at Powell 2NE in southwestern Delaware County. Sector averages for the year are as follows: NW = 15.35"; NE = 15.78"; SE = 17.12", and SW = 16.60". The 4-sector average for the year is 16.21 inches; normal precipitation for the period of January through April at Port Columbus is 10.87 inches. As the growing season begins, the main water supply reservoirs for Central Ohio are at or near their normal pool elevations.
