SUMMARY INFORMATION for February 2004

Precipitation averaged below normal over all four sectors of our network during February. Monthly totals at individual stations ranged from 0.72 of an inch at Johnstown 4WNW in northwestern Licking County to 2.72 inches at Newark Court House 1NE in central Licking County. Sector averages for the month were as follows: NW = 1.59 inches; NE = 1.89 inches; SE = 1.86 inches, and SW = 1.79 inches. The 4-sector average for the month was 1.82 inches; normal precipitation for February at Port Columbus is 2.20 inches. Port Columbus recorded only 1.5 inches of snowfall during February, which is about 4.5 inches below normal. The 2003-2004 seasonal snowfall total at Port Columbus at the end of February was 19.9 inches; normal snowfall for the period of October through February at Port Columbus is 22.6 inches. The bulk of the month's precipitation fell during the first week, with the remainder of the month being relatively dry. The most significant storm of the month occurred on February 5-6.

The storm event of February 5-6 included snow, freezing rain and rain. Precipitation started as snow during the early afternoon of February 5, then changed to light freezing rain in mid-afternoon, and finally changed to rain by early evening. Light to moderate rain fell over the Central Ohio area from early evening on the 5th until about noontime on the 6th. The rainfall accumulation was heavy enough to prompt the National Weather Service to issue flood warnings for Licking and Fairfield Counties during the day on the 6th. In Licking County, the City of Newark, and areas east of Newark were most affected by the flooding. In Fairfield County, small stream flooding was reported county-wide. Most of our volunteers from Licking and Fairfield Counties reported more than 1 inch of rainfall from the storm, with our observer in Newark reporting 1.62 inches. Amounts of 1.0 to 1.5 inches were also common across much of Franklin County.

Even with the below-normal precipitation during February, the overall calendar year precipitation remains well above normal over nearly all of the Central Ohio area. Annual totals at individual stations range from 3.20 inches at New Dover 1SW in central Union County to 9.95 inches at Blacklick Woods 2NNE in extreme east-central Franklin County. Sector averages for the year are as follows: NW = 6.60 inches; NE = 7.57 inches; SE = 7.89 inches, and SW = 7.07 inches. The 4-sector average for the year is 7.28 inches; normal precipitation for the period of January through February at Port Columbus is 4.73 inches. The dry spell during the last 3 weeks of February helped to bring down the Palmer Drought Severity Index by 1 full point, into the "very moist spell" category at the end of February. However, the major Columbus area water supply reservoirs remained at or slightly above their normal /full pool elevations at the end of the month.
