SUMMARY INFORMATION for June 2002

Precipitation averaged below normal over the western half, and above normal over the eastern half of the Central Ohio Raingage Network during June. Monthly totals at individual stations were widely variable, ranging from 1.98 inches in the City of Marion (central Marion County) to 10.31 inches in the City of Newark (central Licking County). Sector averages for June were as follows: NW = 3.42 inches; NE = 4.30 inches; SE = 4.30 inches, and SW = 3.61 inches. The 4-sector average for the month was 3.91 inches; normal precipitation for June at Port Columbus is 4.06 inches. The most significant rainfall period for the network as a whole was between June 1 and June 6, but there were isolated heavy downpours over localized areas at various times during the remainder of the month.

Scattered showers and thundershowers visited the Central Ohio area every day during the period of June 1-6, producing a total accumulation of 2 to 4 inches over most of the area. Amounts of 3 inches or more were generally reported over portions of Dublin, northwestern Columbus, Hilliard, Grove City, southern Franklin and Licking Counties, and northern Fairfield County. Our observer at Carroll 2SW, in west-central Fairfield County, reported 4.4 inches of rainfall during the first 6 days of the month, and 6.7 inches of total rainfall for the first 10 days of June. The most significant isolated storm event in the region occurred during the afternoon of June 27 in the City of Newark. Our observer at Newark Court House 1NE (central Licking County) recorded a total of 5.1 inches of rainfall within a period of less than 6 hours, with most of the rain actually falling in a period of less than 4 hours. The rainfall significantly exceeded a 100-year storm event at that location ... significant flooding was reported by the local newspaper (The Newark Advocate) close to the gage location. Isolated storms with strong winds, and brief heavy downpours also passed over portions of the central Ohio area during the late afternoon of June 26, resulting in downed power lines and tree limbs, and lengthy power outages in scattered areas of the region. Rainfalls in excess of 0.6 of an inch in less than 20 minutes were reported from these storms, with our observer at Johnstown 4WNW in northwestern Licking County reporting 1.04 inches of rainfall in about 30 minutes.

Precipitation for calendar year 2002 is still averaging above normal over all four sectors of the network through June. Annual totals at individual stations range from 14.78 inches in the City of Marion (central Marion County) to 29.99 inches in the City of Newark (central Licking County). Sector averages for the year are as follows: NW = 19.99 inches; NE = 21.94 inches; SE = 21.28 inches, and SW = 20.46 inches. The 4-sector average for the year is 20.92 inches; normal precipitation for the period of January through June at Port Columbus is 18.81 inches. Reservoir levels at Columbus area reservoirs began to drop during the second half of the month in response to the relatively hot and dry weather conditions experienced during that period, but were still in relatively good shape at the end of the month. The Palmer Drought Severity Index, however, did respond quickly to the drier conditions, plunging from the "moist spell" category at the end of May into the "incipient drought" category at the end of June.
