The Central Ohio Raingage Network (CORN) consists of several municipal and N.O.A.A. gages combined with gages of employees or friends of the following organizations: EMH&T, Inc.; ODNR; Dodson-Stilson Assoc.; USGS/Water Resources Division; the City of Delaware, Ashland Chemical Corp., and the Grandview High School Class of 1965.

NOTES:

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1. Gages with daily totals, are generally for those volunteers who report directly to Bob Davis of Evans, Mechwart, Hambleton, and Tilton, Inc. (EMH&T) Consulting Engineers. Information for Port Columbus Airport is obtained from the National Weather Service's Internet web site. For daily totals of other gages in network, contact Dave Cashell at ODNR / Division of Water.
2. Precipitation measurements for the majority of those gages with daily totals are typically taken from plastic rain gages of at least 5-inch capacity.
3. The CORN logogram was designed by Steve Davies of Dodson-Stilson Associates; the location map headings on pages 1 and 2 of this report were prepared by Cheryl Cockrell of EMH&T.

SUMMARY INFORMATION --- May 2000

Precipitation was above normal over a large portion of the Central Ohio area during May. Monthly precipitation totals ranged from 3.33 inches near Marion (Marion County) to 9.10 inches just southeast of New Albany in extreme west-central Licking County. A number of our observers in northeastern Franklin, southeastern Delaware, western Licking, and southwestern Franklin Counties recorded more than 6 inches of total rainfall for the month. Sector averages for May were as follows: NW = 4.88"; NE = 5.96"; SE = 5.29", and SW = 5.40". The 4-sector average for the month was 5.38 inches; normal precipitation for May at Port Columbus is 3.93 inches.

The most significant storms to affect the Central Ohio area occurred during the weekend of the Memorial Golf Tournament in Dublin (May 27 and 28). There was also a damaging storm event on May 23. The scattered rain storms of May 27 and 28 produced between 2 and 3 inches of rain over most of the eastern half, and southwestern portions of Franklin County, and also over eastern Delaware and western Licking Counties. Other areas of Central Ohio generally recorded between 1 and 2 inches of rain during the 2-day period. The scattered showers and thunderstorms of May 23 were much more localized, but also much more intense. The late afternoon and early evening storms produced localized areas of intense rainfall, vivid lightning, hail, damaging winds and funnel clouds/tornadoes. A tornado caused approximately \$200,000 worth of damage to homes near Martel in northeastern Marion County, and storm damage was also reported in Dublin in northwestern Franklin County. Funnel clouds and possible tornadoes were also spotted in Morrow and Fairfield Counties, according to the Marion Star newspaper. One of our volunteers just east of New Albany reported ping-pong ball-size hail with one of these storms. Rainfall amounts were widely variable, but ranged from 1.5 to 2.0 inches in areas in or near Worthington, Westerville, New Albany, Grove City, western Columbus, and Lancaster.

Precipitation for calendar year 2000 is now averaging more than 5 inches above normal for the overall Central Ohio area. Annual totals through May range from 14.81 inches at the City of Delaware Wastewater Treatment Plant (central Delaware County) to 25.70 inches on the west side of New Albany (northeastern Franklin County). Sector averages for the year-to-date are as follows: NW = 19.46"; NE = 20.90"; SE = 19.73", and SW = 19.99". The 4-sector average for the year is 20.02 inches; normal precipitation for the period of January through May is 14.83 inches at Port Columbus. In spite of 5 consecutive months of above-normal precipitation, the Palmer Drought Severity Index of - 2.6 continued to place the Central Ohio climatological region in the "moderate drought" category during the last week in May. While many of our volunteers in or near the Columbus metropolitan area, or south of Columbus, have annual totals significantly above normal, many of the gages in the northern outlying/rural areas of Central Ohio have received only near-normal or slightly above-normal precipitation for the year.
